- Discussion of Chapters 10 and 11 of Beautiful Eucharist took place completing the reading of this text. We will begin to discuss a new book, The Three Ordinary Voices of God, written by Matthew Kelly at our Parish Council meeting on March 4. Be prepared to talk about chapter 1.
- General Updates / Comments
 - 1. Annual winter shoes / jackets / snow pants drive collected 15 jackets, 75 youth shoes, 26 adult shoes and 160 snow pants to benefit 6 Green Bay Area Elementary Schools. All recipients expressed sincere thanks for the donations.
 - 2. The St. Matthew Outreach and Endowment fund received a gift of \$75,000 from a donor along with \$17,380 from Christmas collections. These contributions will enable continued support of St. Matthew outreach projects.
 - 3. The Men's Club from St. Matthew will hold their fundraising social chicken dinner on March 6 at the Swan Club. Tickets can be purchased after mass for \$25.
 - 4. T.J. provided the 2024 Year-End Report for SHP. The total number of beds delivered since the project began in February 2021 is 2,215. In 2024, they delivered 804 beds an increase of 27% over those delivered in 2023. 1,566 volunteers have participated in building the beds and over \$34,000 of bedding donations were received. Additionally, SHP De Pere received a delivery van to enable them to better receive and deliver donations and finished beds. St. Matthew will have a team of volunteers who will assist in the construction of more beds on February 2nd.
