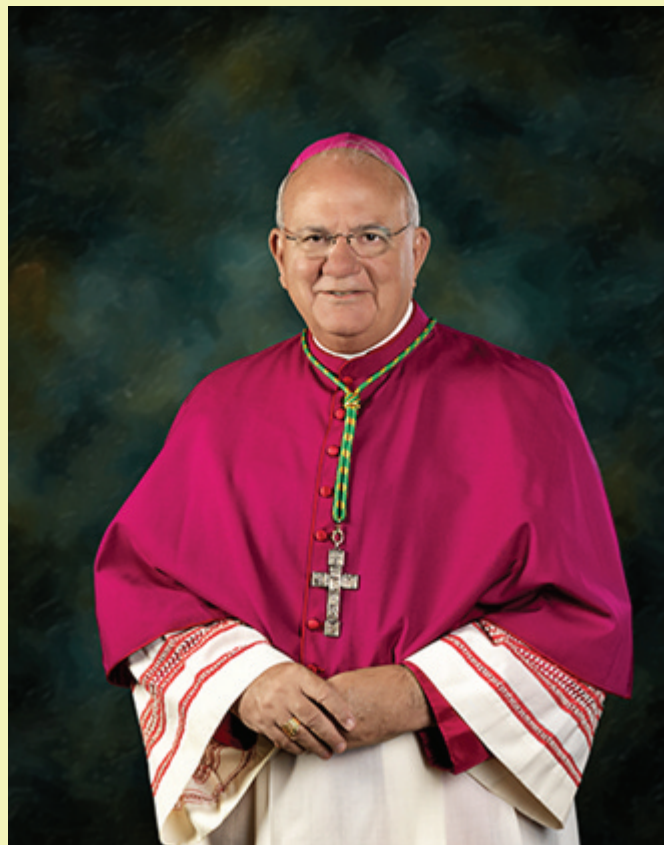

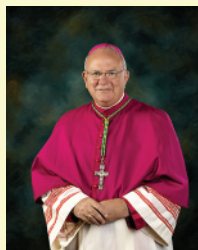

Diocese of St. Petersburg in Transition



Bishop Robert Nugent Lynch announced he has requested retirement having reached the mandatory age limit of 75 for Bishops to retire.

Dear Friends in Christ,

May 27th marked Bishop Lynch's 75th Birthday. This is also the mandatory age of retirement for Bishops. Bishop Lynch sent a letter to Pope Francis in compliance with the age mandate. As a service to the parishioners of Blessed Trinity I am enclosing in this week's bulletin the lengthy process that takes place to select a new Bishop.

Bishop Lynch requested the following phrase be added to our Eucharistic prayers: "... ***For Francis our Pope, Robert our Bishop, and for our new Bishop***". The Bishop believes it is very important for all of God's people to share in prayer during this transitional moment.

In the bulletin this week is a prayer for our new Bishop. I invite all parishioners to pray it during the transition. The Bishop informed the priests of the diocese that he is praying that the anticipation and excitement of waiting for a new shepherd will outweigh the uncertainties that will also be present.

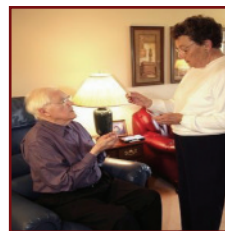

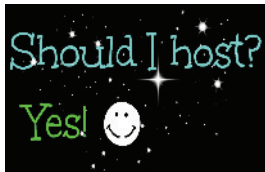
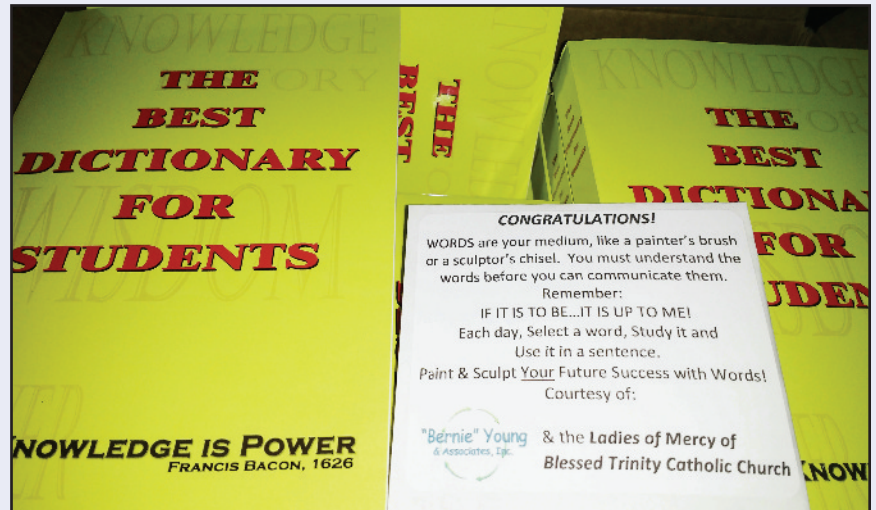
MINISTRY TO THE HOMEBOUND
