Dear Prospective Confirmation Candidate and your family,

Welcome! I am so happy that you are ready to take the next step in your faith formation and enter more deeply into the sacramental life and mysteries of Christ's Church. Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation is a wonderful and important time of your life. It is also a serious undertaking on your part (candidate and family) and the parish community.

I invite you to read the list below and prayerfully discern your commitment to the task of preparation for this sacrament before you complete the attached application for Sacrament Preparation for Confirmation at The Church of the Annunciation.

Qualifications of the Candidate (from the Archdiocesan guidelines for Confirmation Preparation)
Each baptized Catholic has the right and the obligation to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, but he candidate has the responsibility to personally choose to complete initiation into the faith life of the Church. The Candidate may request the Sacrament if he/she:
 □ Is no less than 15 years old at the beginning of the Confirmation preparation year. □ Is baptized and able to renew baptismal promises unless a grave reason suggests otherwise □ Exhibits an active faith life and knowledge of the Church
 Participates in the sacramental life of the Church, especially Eucharistic Liturgies Is committed to active involvement in parish Confirmation catechesis Will respond to the call of serving in the apostolate of the Church
Has completed one year, minimum, systematic catechesis and is committed to continuing education in the Catholic Religion during the sacrament preparation year. (see next page)
 Is committed to learning and growing in the Catholic faith following Confirmation and throughout his/her lifetime Has received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist and leads a life of faith consistent with
the teachings of the Catholic Church. [Has received the healing and graces available in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation.]
☐ Is committed to living the Precepts of the Catholic Church (<i>see below</i>). We understand that Confirmation candidates are dependent upon their parents at this time. However, this will not always be the case. Therefore, candidates should carefully review and commit to life-long obedience of these precepts.
☐ Is willing to participate, as a family, in an initial interview with Confirmation Catechists.
The Precepts of the Catholic Church All Catholics are bound to abide by the "Precepts of the Catholic Church." These laws represent

the minimum standard for living out the Catholic faith.

- 1. To keep holy the day of the Lord's Resurrection: to worship by participating in Mass every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation; to avoid those activities that would hinder renewal of soul and body, these include needless work and business activities, unnecessary shopping, et cetera.
- 2. To lead a sacramental life: to receive Holy Communion frequently and the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation regularly. Minimally, to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year (obligatory annually only if serious sin is involved[, but a healthy practice is once a month.]); to receive Holy Communion at least once a year between Lent and Trinity Sunday.
- To study Catholic teaching in preparation for Confirmation, to be confirmed, and then to continue to study and advance the cause of Christ.

- 4. To observe the marriage laws of the Church: to give religious training (by example and word) to one's children; to use parish schools and religious education programs.
- 5. To strengthen and support the Church, one's own parish community and parish priests, the worldwide Church and the Holy Father.
- 6. To do penance, including abstaining from meat and fasting from food on the appointed days.
- 7. To join in the missionary spirit and apostolate of the Church.

Systematic Catechesis (Religious Education) – The candidate must have completed, at minimum, one year of systematic catechesis in a parish, home school, or parochial school Religious Education program <u>before</u> registering for Confirmation preparation classes. The candidate must continue this education during the preparation year. Texts and work from this year must be presented at time of registration or initial meeting. Those in Home School programs should bring work to each Confirmation preparation class for review.

This is to satisfy the minimum standard of religious doctrine in the faith before the candidate for Confirmation can be confirmed. The minimum is two years of Religious Education at the parish, home school, or parochial school using a curriculum found on the "Conformity List" from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). It is more beneficial if you already have participated in and completed regular grade level (age appropriate) Religious Education programs throughout your formation years. If you are lacking the first year requirement, contact the Religious Education office at religiousED@acchtx.org to discuss how to proceed.

All boxes on the list above should be marked in order to begin preparation classes for Confirmation. We take the responsibility of preparing our youth for the sacrament very seriously. We expect all of the above. **We also expect candidates** <u>and</u> their families to commit to 100 percent of our Confirmation preparation program.

In addition to the classroom sessions, each candidate for Confirmation will discern his/her Sponsor and communicate regularly with him/her while preparing to receive the sacrament; engage in and reflect on service work at the parish and in the community - mindful of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and the Works of Mercy; select and write about his/her chosen Confirmation Saint; and, participate in two retreats (not overnight). (More information will be available at the parent meeting in October.)

Our program is run by volunteers and we ask that you respect their time and commitment, doing your best to participate in all facets of the programs as indicated on the published schedule that will be available at registration. We hope you will prioritize Confirmation Preparation at this time. If you cannot, then you may choose to consider committing to this in a subsequent year.

I look forward to seeing you as you pass through the various elements of the Confirmation Preparation program, culminating in your completion of the Sacraments of Initiation at the Confirmation Mass.
